

NEW Mandatory Training Targeting

The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed the following **new mandatory training**:

• Smoking Cessation: Brief Intervention in Oral Health Settings (Course code: 365368415) Targeting has been updated to include the follow staff categories:

This new module will activated on **11 June 2021**. Existing staff <u>must</u> complete the training within 3 months of targeting, **regardless** of their previous completion status against the superseded Smoking Cessation: Brief Intervention at the Chairside module. New staff <u>must</u> complete during orientation (within 4 weeks).

The Mandatory Training Standing Committee has endorsed three new eLearning modules to **replace** four existing modules. Targeting to commence on 28th May

- Be Aware for Personal Safety (course code 276247273)
- Privacy It's Yours to Keep (course code 326771159)
- Work Health and Safety and Hazardous Manual Tasks (course code 326771497)

New staff, except some Medical Officers will be targeted to the new modules from **28 May 2021** and need to complete the training within the timeframes indicated in the table below.

Existing staff who have completed the original modules do not need to repeat the new training. For *Work Health* and *Safety and Hazardous Manual Tasks,* existing staff who have not completed both original modules will need to complete the new module.

Health

The duration of each new module is up to 15 minutes.

The frequency for each module is once only.

Mandatory Training Targeting Updates

The Mandatory Training Standing Committee (MTSC) has endorsed expanding targeting to **Perinatal Safety Education Newly Endorsed Targeting:**

All midwives, obstetricians and obstetric medical trainees must now be targeted to the training. Those staff who are not captured through the state-wide ANZSCO targeting must be locally identified and targeted.

Those in scope for targeting include:

- Clinical Leads for Obstetrics
- Heads of Department for Obstetrics
- Visiting Medical Officers Obstetrics
- GP Obstetricians
- Clinical Midwife Consultants
- Clinical Midwifery Educators
- Midwifery Educators
- Clinical Nurse Educators who are also Midwives
- Midwifery Managers
- Midwifery Unit Managers
