Shearwater Lodge consists of 15 air conditioned motel style units. Each room contains two single beds, television, wardrobe, microwave oven, electric kettle and toaster. All rooms have an ensuite bathroom and are wheelchair friendly. One room is fully accessible. Rooms are serviced on arrival and departure or on a weekly basis.

Bookings

Emergency

While staying at the Lodge in case of an emergency dial **0 (for a line) and than 000**.

Arrival & Departure

On arrival please go to the Education Centre of the Hospital (office is close to the main entry foyer) between the hours of 1.00pm to 4.00pm. If you are checking in between 4.00pm and 8.30pm please go to the main Hospital Reception where a key may be collected. If you are checking in between 8.30pm and 8.00am or on weekends please proceed to the Emergency Department reception. Emergency Department **6656 7000**. A refundable key deposit is required on arrival.



Parking

Designated parking is available for the exclusive use of patients and their carers while residing at Shearwater Lodge.

Valuables

No responsibility can be taken for the loss of/or damage to any resident's property.

Security

The premises are patrolled regularly by security guards. If you have any concerns regarding security, please **dial the Hospital Reception on 9**.

Smoking

Smoking is **strictly forbidden** in all areas of the Lodge and within the entire Hospital site.

Common Room, Kitchen, Dining & Lounge Areas

There are two spacious common rooms, which include kitchen and lounge area where residents can mingle, and prepare meals. Weekly morning teas and Wednesday evening meals are provided for guests by service groups from the community. The rear Common Room has internet facilities for the use of guests and also wireless internet is available in all rooms for laptop computers.

Laundry Facilities

A coin-operated laundry is available for the use of residents.



Transport

Local bus companies operate daily. A public bus stop is located at the entrance of the Coff's Harbour Health Campus. A golf buggy is available to take guests to the Cancer Institute if they have difficulty walking from the Lodge.

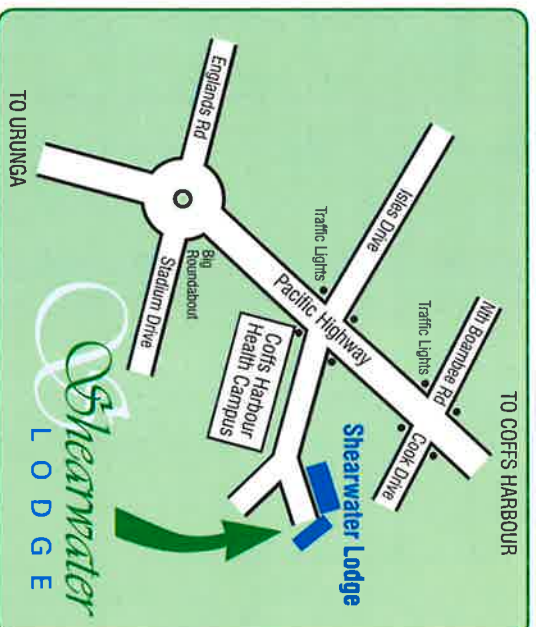


Cancer Information & Support
